In an effort to continue this vital service to our students, Communities In Schools is **officially announcing the beginning of its 2017 Tools for Schools drive**! To make this drive even more successful than those of previous years, we are reorganizing the way in which we collect donations. We often find ourselves bombarded by Crayons and notebooks, but short on important supplies like scientific calculators and binders. To alleviate this issue, this year CIS will be focusing its efforts primarily on raising monetary donations. This will allow us to purchase the supplies we need when we need them. To encourage donations, we have created a variety of fundraising events that will help your organization continue to raise funds for the cause. They are listed below:

<u>Dress Down Day</u> - Give \$5 to wear jeans and/or \$5 to wear tennis shoes! <u>Raffle for Prizes</u> - Employees pay \$5 per ticket; prizes could include prime parking spots, a vacation day, or more! <u>Ugly Tie Contest</u> - Everyone can bring their ugliest tie; \$1 = 1 vote. The ugliest tie wins a prize! <u>Workplace Auction</u> - Employees may bring an item, whether valuable or goofy, and coworkers bid to win. Winning bids benefit CIS!

We encourage you to host 2-3 of these events within your workplaces to rally your coworkers behind a cause that matters- **helping at-risk youth succeed**. Tools for Schools partners may select which events would work best for them and adjust them to fit the culture of their environment.
